RESOLUTION.

Whereas, it appears from the returns of the Board of Canvassers of the returns of the special election held July 26, 1927, that there were cast at said election 3,496 votes, of which number, 2,730 votes were cast in favor of the proposition to issue the \$130,000 Saline County Court House and Jail bonds, and 766 votes were cast against the said proposition;

AND WHEREAS, it appears from said returns that the necessary majority of the votes were cast in favor of the issuance of said bonds,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Saline County Nebraska, that it be and it is hereby declared that the proposition to issue \$130,000 Saline County Court House and Jail Bonds, submitted at the special election on July 26, 1927, was duly carried and the issuance of said bonds was duly authorized.

The following resolution was presented by Commissioner Tavis, who moved its adoption.

"RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$130,000 OF SALINE COUNTY COURT HOUSE AND JAIL BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF SALINE AND STATE OF NEBRASKA."

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Saline County Nebraska, did at a meeting thereof, held on the 20th

Sec. II. That there is hereby ordered to be issued the negotiable coupon bonds of said County in the aggregate sum of \$130,000 for the purposes aforesaid.

Sec. III. That the bonds hereby authorized be 130 in number numbered from 1 to 130 both inclusive, of the denomination of \$1,000 each to be known as "SALINE COUNTY COURT HOUSE AND JAIL BONDS" bearing date of December 1, 1927, to become due and payable on December 1, 1937, provided the whole or any portion of said bonds may be redeemed at the option of said County in multiples of \$1,000 on any interest payment date at any time after five (5) years from the date thereof; that such bonds bear interest at the rate of $4\frac{1}{2}\%$ per annum from date until paid, payable semi-annually on the 1st day of June and the first day of December of each and every year until paid; that such bonds be signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and attested and countersigned by the County Clerk of Saline County Nebraska; that the interest accruing on said bonds be evidenced by coupons thereto attached, maturing on the days when such interest matures and that such coupons be signed by the Chairman of this Board and said County Clerk by their fac-simile signature and that said Chairman and County Clerk shall, by the execution of said bonds, adopt as and for their proper signatures, said fac-simile signatures appearing on said coupons; that said bonds and coupons be payable at the office of the County Treasurer of Saline County in Wilber, Saline County, Nebraska, and that such bonds be registered by the County Attorney upon being properly signed and attested, in the office of the Auditor of Public Accounts of the State of Nebraska, and in the office of the County Clerk of the County of Saline Nebraska, as provided by law.

Sec. IV. That said bonds and coupons and certificates of the County Clerk and the Auditor of Public Accounts be in substantially the following form:

The County of Saline, in the State of Nebraska, for value received, promises to pay to bearer ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) lawful money of the United States of America on the first day of December, 1937, with interest on said sum from date hereof until paid at the rate of four and one-half ($4\frac{1}{2}$) percent per annum, payable semi-annually, on the first day of June and the first day of December in each year, upon presentation and surrender of the interest coupons hereto attached as they severally mature. Both principal and interest are hereby made payable at the office of the County Treasurer of the County of Saline, in the City of Wilber Nebraska. For the payment of this

bond, both principal and interest, as the same matures and for the levy of taxes sufficient for that purpose, the full faith, credit and resources of said County are hereby pledged.

This bond is one of a series, consecutively numbered from 1 to 130, both inclusive, bearing the same date and for a like amount.

This bond may be redeemed by said County on any interest payment date at any time after ~~De~~ June 1, 1932.

This bond is issued by the Board of ^{County} ~~Commissioners~~ of said County, pursuant to the provisions of Article IV of Chapter 13 of the Compiled Statutes of Nebraska, for 1922, and amendments thereto, in conformity with resolutions of said Board duly passed, and is authorized by a vote of more than a majority of the voters of said County at an election duly called and held within the County of Saline, ^{present and future} upon the question of issuing such bonds, and is issued for the purpose of erecting and constructing a suitable court house and jail building in and for said County.

And it is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required by the laws and the Constitution of the State of Nebraska to be done precedent to and in the issuing of this bond, have been properly done, happened and been performed in regular and due form and time as required by law, and that the total indebtedness of said County, including this bond, does not exceed any limitation imposed by law.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, said County, by its Board of County Commissioners, has caused this bond to be signed by the Chairman and attested and counter-signed by the County Clerk of said County, and the coupons hereto attached to be signed by said Chairman and Clerk by their fac-simile signature, and said Chairman and Clerk do, by the execution hereof, adopt as and for their own proper signatures, their fac-simile signatures appearing on said coupons, all this first day of December, 1927.
